


BEHIND THE BARRELS:

IRANIAN OIL AND POLITICAL TIES IN GEORGIA



While the Iranian government continues to suppress dissent and reportedly kill thousands of citizens protesting for freedom and independence, Georgian Dream brazenly continues diplomatic endorsement of the autocratic regime. On February 11, 2026, Tbilisi Television Tower [was illuminated](#) in the colors of the Islamic Republic to mark the 47th anniversary of the Islamic Revolution.

Iran's Ambassador to Georgia, Ali Moujani, stated that the gesture reflected the historic ties between Iran and Georgia, as well as the **positive relations** between the two countries. According to the Ambassador, the illumination of the tower served as "**a clear symbol of the fact that respect for today's Iran's is officially and internationally recognized**"(Ambassador's [post](#) on X, February 11, 2026).




In this report, we will expose the 'economic' cooperation that Darsalia proudly highlighted in his speech at the Iranian Embassy.


KEY RESEARCH FINDINGS

According to the official data and documents available to us, **72 companies** registered in Georgia imported Iranian oil and petroleum products in **2022-2025**.



15 companies are related to citizens of **foreign, third countries**
- Azerbaijan, Kazakhstan and Armenia.




10 companies are related to Iranian citizens, and 2 companies have **Iranian citizens** among their partners as managers/shareholders.




8 companies are related to **donors of the Georgian Dream**; 3 of these companies are winners of state tenders.



8 companies have **contracts** with various state agencies and managers/ shareholders of 3 companies are linked to other entities, who won state contracts.



5 companies are indirectly related to **donors of the Georgian Dream**. In particular, Aisi LLC, Ihlas LLC, Bakhula Motors LLC, Baza-22 LLC, Sulfeco LLC are the member organizations of the NNLE "[Waste Management Business Association](#)" operating in Georgia. The president of the association is [Bakur Khundadze](#), who is a donor to the Georgian Dream.



4 companies are indirectly connected to **public/political officials and members of the Georgian Parliament**, including a former MP from the Georgian Dream party.

Iranian oil and political ties in Georgia

The anti-Western foreign policy of the Georgian Dream party is creating a favorable geopolitical environment for cooperation with authoritarian regimes. The foreign policy and actions of the Georgian Dream are transforming Georgia into a connecting territory for the Russia-China-Iran “axis of evil.”¹ This trend is directly reflected on Georgia-Iran relations.

The subject of our research is **the dynamics of the share of imports of Iranian petroleum products in the Georgian market.**

It is important to highlight from the beginning that, based on the analysis of publicly available information and various data, there is a deplorable trend that under the rule of the Georgian Dream, **the share of imports of Iranian petroleum products in the Georgian market and, accordingly, the country's dependence on energy carriers from the Islamic Republic of Iran is steadily increasing.**

For comparison, compared to the figures for 2020, the quantity and value of oil and petroleum products imported from Iran in 2025 are characterized by an increasing trend (see **Chart #1²**). Specifically:

1,346 tons of oil and petroleum products were imported from Iran. By 2025, this amount had **doubled** to 2,740 tons.

In 2020 the value of oil and petroleum products imported from Iran amounted to 683,000 USD, while in 2025, this figure **increased by approximately 3.5 times**, reaching 2,413,000 USD.

1. The term [“axis of evil”](#) was used by U.S. President George W. Bush. The “axis of evil” referred to the hostile tendencies emanating from authoritarian regimes:

“states like these (North Korea, Iran, Iraq), and their terrorist allies, constitute an axis of evil, arming to threaten the peace of the world. ([George W. Bush, 29/01/2002](#))

This term remains relevant among representatives of the U.S. political elite and in academic circles. The “axis of evil” refers to all those revisionist undemocratic regimes that oppose the existing international order. In 2023, Republican Senator Mitch McConnell [stated](#) that the China-Russia-Iran axis of evil poses a “direct threat” to the United States.

On the official [website of Geostat](#), the category of petroleum and petroleum products is presented as: “271019 Medium and heavy distillates; petroleum and petroleum products obtained from bituminous rocks, other than crude; and products of petroleum or petroleum products obtained from bituminous rocks, containing by weight 70% or more of petroleum or petroleum products, not elsewhere specified or included”.



It is noteworthy that the price of oil and petroleum products imported from Iran is characterized by an increasing trend. Moreover, the value of imported products, despite the decrease in quantity, is increasing. In 2025, compared to 2023, 1,397 tons less energy products were imported from Iran to Georgia. Despite the decrease in the quantity of imported products, in 2025, compared to 2023, 671,000 USD more was spent on Iranian oil and petroleum products.

The average price of imported Iranian oil and petroleum products exceeds the corresponding rates of Georgia's largest energy product importers, such as Azerbaijan, Romania, Turkmenistan, and Russia (see Chart #2).





Chart #2:

Average Price of Oil and Petroleum Products, by Year.


A comparison of the average prices of imported oil and petroleum products in December 2025 with those in December 2023 reveals the following trend: **the average price per ton of Iranian oil and petroleum products increased by approximately threefold**, reaching 1,038.5 USD. In contrast, the average price of the same products imported from other countries either declined—Azerbaijan's rate decreased from 733.6 USD to 656.2 USD, Russia's from 770.2 USD to 659.9 USD, and Turkmenistan's from 870.7 USD to 770.3 USD—or increased only marginally, as in the case of Romania, where the rate rose from 818.5 USD to 832.6 USD (see **Chart #3**).



In parallel with the intensification of Georgia- Iran trade relations, the Georgian Dream is trying to hide the reality and denies the positive dynamics of relations in public statements. In an interview with [TRT World](#) on November 7, 2025, Ivanishvili's Prime Minister, Irakli Kobakhidze, noted:




It seems that Mr. Kobakhidze forgets or ignores the fact that Iran is ruled by an authoritarian and revisionist power. In turn, the stability of the Ayatollah regime depends precisely on the export of energy products. For example, in 2024, Iran's [oil export revenues amounted](#) to \$43 billion, which is more than 57% of the country's total export revenue. In this sense, the purchase of Iranian petroleum products by companies registered in Georgia amounts to indirect financial support for the Ayatollah regime.



[In the report](#) published by Civic IDEA titled "**The Anti-Western Policy of the Georgian Dream – An Opportunity for Iran**", we analyzed Iranian-language sources to uncover the strategies employed by Iranian business groups to utilize Georgian territory in order to bypass international sanctions.

Today, we present a study on the companies and individuals who imported Iranian oil and petroleum products into Georgia in 2022-2025, their connections and activities.


Companies linked to Iranian citizens

Some companies importing Iranian oil and petroleum products in Georgia are founded by Iranian citizens themselves. Among the importing companies, there are also LLCs whose founders are Georgian citizens who are business partners of Iranian citizens.

The research showed that Iranian citizens linked to the importing companies also run other businesses in Iran. **Moreover, one of the Iranian citizens who owns shares in a company registered in Georgia is linked to an Iranian company that had sanctions imposed by the United States.**

We present information about the managers, shareholders and persons related to the latter of the aforementioned companies:

1 DORRAN-GEORGIA LLC. (No.: 406217080)




As of 2025, the company has been operating in Georgia since 2017. Its director and 100% shareholder is Iranian citizen **Asghar Panahi Dorchecheh**. Dorran-Georgia imported oil and petroleum products from Iran in **2022-2025**. Information about Dorran-Georgia LLC is also available on Iranian-language [websites](#).

Information on Iranian websites indicates that the company also has a local branch in Isfahan, Iran, called: **Dorran Oil Office**.

As for the founder of Dorran-Georgia LLC, Asghar Panahi Dorcheh, his name is associated with the Iranian **Behran Oil Co.**, which is a leading manufacturer of lubricating oils in the Iranian market. According to the company's official website, Asghar Panahi Dorcheh is a sales representative.

Behran Oil Co. [was placed under secondary sanctions](#) by the US Treasury Department in 2022. As reported by the US Treasury Department, the company is directly or indirectly owned by the Bonyad Mostazafan Foundation, a business association controlled by the Supreme Leader of Iran.



DORRAN-GEORGIA, an importer of Iranian oil and petroleum products in Georgia, is directly linked to an Iranian national who is an employee of a sanctioned Iranian company.

Global Trading Commodity G.T.C. LLC (Registration No.: 427733269)

According to [2022 data](#), the company was registered in Georgia in 2016 and imported oil and petroleum products from Iran in **2022**. The company's directors and shareholders are Iranian citizens **Hossein Moshaveri Najafabadi** and **Hassan Aghamohammadzadeh**.

The shareholders of the importer company, Hossein Moshaveri Najafabadi and Hassan Aghamohammadzadeh, are associated with a number of Georgian companies. Notably, through his companies, Hassan Aghamohammadzadeh cooperates with Georgian and Azerbaijani individuals (**see the scheme below**).

Akbarinezhad, through the company **Tabriz Izogram** exports oil and petroleum products from Iran.

Thus, **Akbarinezhad**, a partner of Saber Najafi Haghi, is an active exporter of Iranian petroleum products. His company is a member of the Iranian “**Oil, Gas and Petrochemical Exporters Union**” (OPEX). This union was founded in 2004 and, despite operating under a “non-governmental” mandate, the activities of both its board of directors and the union itself are closely linked to the Islamic Republic of Iran. For example, in the founding [charter](#), the Union’s duties include: providing expert opinions or recommendations to the country’s government agencies for the purpose of adopting laws and regulations facilitating the export of oil, gas and petroleum products; collaborating with public and private sector representatives to strengthen exports, etc.

World Trans Logistics LLC, which imported Iranian oil and petroleum products into Georgia, is linked to Iranian citizens who own various businesses in the relevant sector in Iran. These connections are not accidental, and as we noted in our previous report, Iranian businessmen are attempting to circumvent international sanctions by using various fraudulent schemes.

According to the [2025 extract](#), Aisi LLC was registered in the Public Registry on February 28, 2005. The company trades in lubricants, coolants and other oil products. It imported oil and petroleum products from Iran to Georgia in **2022-2025**. The sole manager and director of the company is Georgian citizen Irma Pataria.

The company also has experience in cooperating with state agencies. In particular, several [contracts](#) concluded with it through simplified procurement in 2012-2015 are publicly available.

Irma Pataria also has other companies registered in Georgia where Iranian citizens are her partners.




